- · Possesses a National C license or higher from US Soccer.
- Designing a Coach's Code of Conduct. Train and monitor the team coaches and help them plan and implement practice sessions. Design and administer a continuing education program for the team coaches. Conduct coaches clinics. Design manuals for the team coaches. Bring experts such as state, regional, and national staff coaches, to present clinics.
- Create long and short-term seasonal plans for the club and provide guidance to the team coaches in designing their own team's season plan.
- Design and administer the team's tryouts.
- Design the training priorities for each age group and level.
- Design a player evaluation/feedback process that guides the team coaches in how and when to provide feedback to the players.
- Create a college recruiting information program and educate the player and parents on college playing opportunities.
- Assist in the design and implementation of a parent education program that would include parent meetings, parent handouts, handouts and occasional seminars.
- Represent the club at State, Regional and National coaching seminars and workshops.
- Encourage ethics among club members and within the entire soccer community.
- DOC should have the final say regarding the following.
 - Assigning and releasing of coaches.
 - Organize the tryout process and have the final say on player placement.
 - Have the final say on player development issues such as playing up, playing format, training priorities, important club-wide standards and policies.
